- Wax crayon
- A piece of white paper
- Put the leaves back if you're not going to use them for craft.


Some leaves

• Don't pick stinging nettles.

• Try to use fallen leaves.

HOW TO LEAF RUB

- 1 Simply place the leaf under the piece of paper, with underside facing up.
- 2 Use the side of the crayon and gentle rub all over the area of the leaf until you can see its pattern emerging.
- **3** Use either a book or the internet to help you identify the leaves.



LEAFY HEDGEHOGS



With the leaves you collected use the crayon to draw the face and body of the hedgehog. Then with a little glue make a really cute little leafy hedgehog.
